## WHAT TO EXPECT

Town Hall Clinics are come and go events meaning you may come and go as you please anywhere between the hours listed above. You will park and head straight to the tent near the driving range for a brief sign-in. Bring what clubs you have, otherwise just bring yourself and we will provide the rest! Please plan to meet the HUGS League Board members, learn more about our League, learn tips from our golf coaches, practice your game, and of course sign up for the Fall League if you have not already! Families are welcome at all clinics and will have an opportunity to chip, putt, and hit at the range when space is available. Everything (golf related) is free at these clinics. This is a relaxed atmosphere where you can simply feel free to learn golf and chat with others who have similar backgrounds and interests.

**Game Time:** Please plan to arrive at least one hour before your time. You will meet and sign in at the table in front of the clubhouse. Then you will play 9 holes with your team. Once you finish playing please turn your card in at the pro shop in the clubhouse.

The first three weeks of League play (August 29, September 12 and 26<sup>th</sup>) are your opportunity 9-hole rounds. This is your opportunity to establish your handicap, get to know your teammates, and build your team. These rounds will not count towards the season total. Our focus here is team building, camaraderie, and practicing what you have learned from the Town Hall Clinics. Prizes will be awarded to the top team each week.

The last three rounds (October 10<sup>th</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, and November 7<sup>th</sup>) your teams will be set and will be divided into three flights (competitive, intermediate, and progressing) based on abilities. Again, at this point your team will be set. These rounds will count towards the standings and end of season awards. Prizes will be awarded at each event and overall winners will be determined based on a point system that accumulate at the Grand Finale Tournament and Awards Dinner.

**Tournament and Awards Dinner:** Please plan to arrive at least one hour before the event begins at 1230 pm. You will sign in at the table in front of the clubhouse, practice, and play 18 holes with your team. Once you finish, we will gather at the clubhouse for a Grand Finale Awards Dinner. This will be a buffet dinner and include awards and prizes. The awards dinner is tentatively a player only event.

## WHAT HAPPENS IF...?

If it is raining and you are not sure about whether we are playing, please check our social media. There are no make up days.

If you cannot play in one of the games, please coordinate with your team. Your teammates will rotate through your play.



### WHERE IS THE RESTROOM?

The restroom is in the clubhouse and 1 station is located within the front nine holes and another station is in the back nine holes.

### I'M HUNGRY AND THIRSTY, NOW WHAT?

The League suggests you always come prepared with water. However, at Clinics we will have water. You are welcome to treat yourself to food and drink at the Harmony Clubhouse. HUGS League is a non-alcoholic event, so **alcohol is prohibited while at all HUGS League events.**
